Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: **Adami**

Language: **Hebrew**

Pronunciation: **ad-aw-mee'**

Meaning: The name 'Adami' means 'Red Earth' or 'Red Soil.' It is derived from the Hebrew root word 'Adam' meaning 'to show blood in the face', a word most often used to denote the color red (the color of blood); and generally has reference to the following words: 'ruddy', 'red', 'rosey', or 'blush.'

The word 'Adami' generally has reference to 'soil', 'ground', 'land', 'country', 'territory' or 'earth' (reddish in appearance due to the tilling process). The city of 'Adami' was located within the allotted territory belonging to the tribe of Naphtali, and probably served as a farming community.

Please note: 'Adami' is synonymous with the name 'Adamah.'
