Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: Admah Language: Hebrew Pronunciation: ad-maw'

Meaning: The name 'Admah' means 'Red Earth' or 'Red Soil.' It is derived from the Hebrew root word 'Adam' meaning 'to show blood in the face', a word most often used to denote the color red (the color of blood); and generally has reference to the following words: 'ruddy', 'red', 'rosey', or 'blush.'

The word 'Admah' generally has reference to 'soil', 'ground', 'land', 'country', 'territory' or 'earth' (from its red-like appearance during the tilling process). The city of 'Admah' was destroyed along with Sodom, Gomorrah and Zeboim. It was located on the southeast side of the Dead Sea.

Alternative meanings include: 'Earthy.'

Please note: 'Admah' is synonymous with the name 'Adamah.'
