Bible Name Dictionary

Bible Name: Baasha Language: Hebrew Pronunciation: bah-shaw'

Meaning: The name 'Baasha' means 'Offensive.' It is derived from the Hebrew root word 'Basha' meaning 'to stink' (in the sense of extreme moral wickedness in an offensive manner).

Alternative meanings include: 'Wicked', 'Abominable' or 'Bold.'

Please note: The word 'Basha' generally has reference to a morally wicked individual. It is very much akin to the word 'abomination' (in the sense of religious idolatry). How so? The Bible generally depicts an abomination (i.e., idolatry) as producing a stink (i.e., an offensive odor) in the Lord's nostrils.

*** The name 'Baasha' most likely depicts a person heavily involved in idolatries cult worship. ***

(Not only that... but this person is extremely bold with his wicked behavior.)
